Purpose of the role:

To manage the training/learning for adults within the county in Northamptonshire.

Main Tasks

- ✿ Working with CTM (Managing) work with County Commissioner and District Commissioner's to determine, review and maintain the appropriate vision and structure for management and support of learning opportunities within the County
- ✿ Implement the county training strategy in line with the principles of the Scout Association's Adult Training Scheme
- ✿ Plan and ensure the delivery of a high quality learning provision in the County so that all adults in Scouting completing a PLP have access to the suitable learning opportunities using a variety of methods including that venues and trainers are in place where needed
- ✿ Ensure that all those involved in the delivery and administration of training have effective line management either directly by the CTM or by others
- ✿ Ensure that people involved in the delivery of the learning provision are suitably qualified and effective
- ✿ Ensure that the delivery of the learning provision is to a high standard and that processes are in place to ensure continual review and improvement
- ✿ Ensure that the delivery of the learning provision reflects both national and local priorities
- ✿ Ensure that administration relevant to learning/training is completed efficiently and effectively
- ✿ Work with the Regional Training Manager and other County Training Managers in the region to share ideas and support the development of the training provision in the County
- ✿ Any other duties agreed that are relevant to the role
