Purpose of the role:

To manage the support for adults within the county in Northamptonshire in the areas of learning/training

Responsible for:

County Local Training Managers, County Training Advisors

Responsible to:

County Commissioner or approved nominee

Main Tasks

- ✿ Working with CTM (Delivery) work with County Commissioner and District Commissioner's to determine, review and maintain the appropriate vision and structure for management and support of learning opportunities within the County
- ✿ Working closely with District Commissioners, ensure that all of the county is covered by a suitable County Local Training Manager
- ✿ Implement the county training strategy in line with the principles of the Scout Association's Adult Training Scheme
- ✿ Ensure that all those involved in the management of training have effective line management either directly by the CTM or by others
- ✿ Ensure that administration relevant to learning/training is completed efficiently and effectively
- ✿ Ensure that all County Training Advisors are trained, appropriately informed and valued
- ✿ Ensure that the recommendation of Wood Badges is carried out in a timely and efficient manner
- ✿ Work with the Regional Training Manager and other County Training Managers in the region to share ideas and support the development of the training provision in the County
- ✿ Any other duties agreed that are relevant to the role
